1. What do you learn from these scriptures?

3. (1 Corinthians 3:16; 16:19-30) What do these verses teach you about yourself? How do they help to describe your purpose in life?

MESSAGE

1. Like John, How have you wrestled with the reality of the Kingdom of God in the midst of pain and confusion?
2. How would you describe the person whom you know that you would consider a "spiritually great"?
3. Prior to this message how would you define "spiritual greatness"? How would you define it now?
4. (Scale 1-7) How willing are you to point people to Jesus? Explain your answer.

RESPONSE

1. What can you do today to point people to Jesus?
2. How does your agenda get in the way of the 'Kingdom agenda' (pointing people to Jesus)?
3. As a result of this message, what does God expect of you?
4. How can God use you, in your current circumstances, to point people to Jesus? Will you commit to pray in this regard?
