for <u>gaining</u> wisdom and instruction; for <u>understanding</u> words of insight; for <u>receiving</u> instruction in prudent behavior, <u>doing</u> what is right and just and fair; for giving prudence to those who are simple, knowledge and discretion to the young—let the wise <u>listen</u> and <u>add to</u> their learning, and let the discerning <u>get</u> guidance—for understanding parables, the sayings and riddles of the wise.
