## **KEY SCRIPTURES**

- 1. Do you think the description given to Laodicea as "the church in denial" is appropriate? If so, why or why not?
- 2. Wealth is amoral, neither good nor bad morally, so why is wealth sometimes a disadvantage spiritually?
- 3. What are some of the ways we can fall into denial related to our spiritual intimacy with Jesus?
- 4. The analogy of Jesus vomiting lukewarm water seems harsh, what does it imply about the importance of spiritual intimacy in our daily walk with Jesus?
- 5. Why does Jesus rebuke the church at Laodicea? What is His driving motive?
- 6. In Revelation 3:20 the word picture is that of Jesus *knocking at a door*. What does that imply about Jesus' desire for us and what does it imply about what we should do?
- 7. Spiritual renewal is a partnership with God. What is God's part and what is our part?
- 8. Spiritual intimacy is more of a journey than a single event. What is implied in a *daily journey toward* spiritual intimacy that is different that a *single* event?
