

The wicked hunt down the innocent because **in their arrogance** they lose sight of the God who extended authority to them (8:7-8; 10:2-11).

3 CHALLENGES

1. Don't lose your perspective (10:1, 4, 11)
2. Don't lose sight of your mortality (9:19-20; 9:12)

Arise Lord, do not let **mortals** triumph; let the nations be judged in your presence. Strike them with terror, Lord; let the nations know they are only **mortal**.

3 CHALLENGES
